What to bring?

<u>Sunscreen</u> - A hat (large with string) and shirt or cover-up is essential. 30 SPF or higher and lip cream. Please do not bring sunscreen in aerosol spray bottles as the overspray can be dangerous on deck.

 \underline{Music} – Anatolya has mini-phono jack input for digital music players/phones. We also have a CD player.

<u>Specialty Beverages</u> - You may bring with you any specialty beverages you desire. Anatolya stocks common brands and flavors of soda and juice on board. Additionally, optional Bar Packages of beer and wine can be purchased as specified.

<u>Sandals/Flip-Flops/Crocs</u> – Barefoot is the general rule on Anatolya. However, soft, white soled shoes are acceptable. You should also consider bringing in-water shoes for occasions where we dinghy to a beach. Marking or hard-soled shoes and high heels are banned aboard Anatolya.

<u>Towels</u> – A beach and/or bath towel is essential. Showers are available aboard Anatolya for your use. Simple soap is provided. You're welcome to bring shampoo and other soap products that you favor.

<u>Camera</u> – or camera/phone is must-have for all the opportunities you'll have

<u>Lifejacket</u> – Anatolya has a full set of USCG approved lifejackets onboard for up to 12 passengers. Our lifejackets are the very safe, albeit standard-issue bulky orange kind. If you prefer to bring your own more stylish, comfortable (perhaps self-inflating type), please feel free.

What NOT to bring

<u>Illegal Drugs</u> - You may not do or bring illegal DRUGS aboard Anatolya. No illegal drug use is tolerated. Violate this rule and you will be put ashore promptly at the nearest location. This includes underage use of alcohol or cigarettes. Non-compliance of this rule will result in the termination of the sail and no refund will be given.
